After the Rai1 biopic on the life of Tina Anselmi, *Tina Anselmi - A Life for Democracy*, she began a collaboration with director Luca Lucini, for whom she wrote *My Paper Girls*, a coming-of-age film presented at the Bifest in Bari, *My Brother and Me*, a comedy for Amazon Prime, and *Stella Gemella*, a feature film starring Margherita Buy and Laura Morante, presented at the Rome Film Festival.
